It is important that you make plans for your digital possessions in a similar way to how you might make plans for your physical possessions.



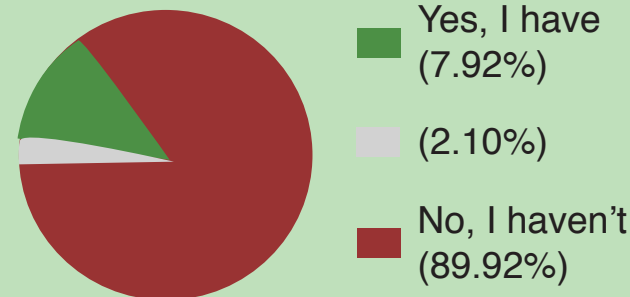

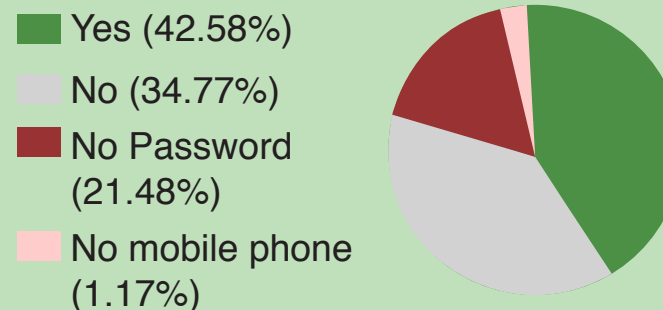

DIGITAL LIFE CHECKLIST

1 You may want to think and make plans to pass on passwords for your online accounts and the devices that you use.

If you use social networks you may want to download your photos and videos from the services you use and pass them onto your next of kin.

You may also want to provide administrative access of your social media accounts to someone you trust.



3 If you have online subscriptions or online bank accounts you may want to make suitable plans for each.

4 If you have photos or videos stored on electronic devices or in the cloud you may want to make a folder of your favourite photos and share them with a friend or family member. Sharing can occur through various internet services or by using an external memory stick or a hard drive.

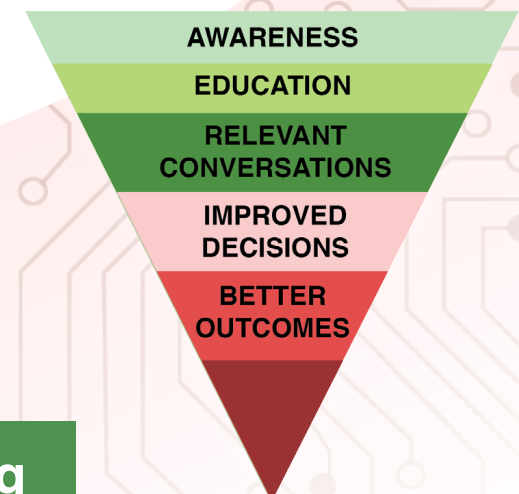
